Subject : REACH regulation

Dear Customer,

REACH came into force on 1 June 2007. We would therefore like to inform you by means of this letter about the activities, which Eurofoam GmbH will undertake with respect to the new European Chemical legislation.

Eurofoam – in cooperation with our parent company Recticel SA – has commenced a project to determine and evaluate the impact of REACH on its polyurethane products. Eurofoam, as a downstream user (i.e. a producer of PU articles), is not subject to (pre-) registration. Only manufacturers or importers who place chemicals in the stream of commerce are obliged to register the latter.

However, in order to guarantee our obligations according to REACH, Eurofoam together with Recticel has started an extensive evaluation process. All our suppliers are being asked if they pre-register the chemicals, which we use and if the future availability of their supplied products is ensured for the future. This also guarantees you the continued unrestricted supply of our goods. Within the broader scope of the REACH project, Eurofoam together with its suppliers, will have to evaluate the safe use of the respective products. To do so we may also need your support in the future.

In this respect we can also inform you that Eurofoam and Recticel are strongly involved in the REACH Working Group of EUROPUR (European Association of Flexible Polyurethane block foam manufacturers).

We assure you that Eurofoam is working extensively and responsibly to act in accordance with the tasks awarded to the company by REACH.
